The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 182 dated 09.07.2007, under Sections 148, 149, 325 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner and another accused, who were employees of the petrol pump, had an altercation with the Manager. The petitioner was not aware of the proceedings and has not been declared as a 'proclaimed offender' and the co-accused, who was facing trial, has been acquitted. He also contends that the similarly situated co-accused Bijender Singh has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court by order dated 03.11.2020 passed in CRM-M No. 21139 of 2020.

This Court, by the order dated 01.11.2021, had directed petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 30.11.2021 and has been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, the order dated 01.11.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
