The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 225 dated 30.06.2018, under Sections 307, 452 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner is named in the FIR, but he was found innocent during investigation. He, however, contends that the petitioner has been involved because he is the brother-in-law of main accused Jaswant, who has a dispute with the complainant. The petitioner was found innocent during investigation and his name was mentioned in column No. 2. It is alleged that the complainant was set on fire after being sprinkled with petrol. The complainant has fully recovered from the injuries.

This Court, by the order dated 02.11.2021, had directed petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and in the event of his doing so, he was ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 16.11.2021 and has been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, the order dated 02.11.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
