This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by the petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated 26.07.2021 to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P-5, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Sullar, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, to look into and decide representation dated 26.07.2021 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Nothing in this order would be taken as expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
