Petitioner Sarabjit Singh is feeling aggrieved by order dated 16.07.2021 passed by Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, SBS Nagar, vide which an application U/o 1 Rule 10(2) CPC filed by him for deletion of his name from the array of respondents has been declined.

I have heard learned legal aid counsel for the petitioner besides going through the record and I find that the revision petition is absolutely without merit.

A perusal of the record goes to show that the present petitioner had moved an application before the Tribunal for getting his name deleted as respondent, alleging that no accident had taken place with his vehicle and an enquiry in that regard is pending with the police authorities; the revisionist has been arrayed as respondent merely for the reason that registration number of his vehicle is mentioned in the FIR and

he is owner of that vehicle without there being cogent and convincing evidence to connect the vehicle with the mishap.

The Tribunal did not agree with such contentions of the revisionist observing that the registration number of the vehicle is mentioned in the FIR and the present revisionist, who is respondent in the claim petition is owner of the said vehicle and onus is upon him to disclose the name of the driver, who was driving the vehicle at the relevant time, therefore, the application was dismissed.

I find that the order is quite detailed, well reasoned, does not suffer from any illegality or infirmity. No interference by this Court while exercising revisional jurisdiction is called for. The revision petition stands dismissed accordingly.
