The grievance of the petitioner is that respondent No.8 has allegedly forged documents for getting a passport and has furnished wrong information therein. The said respondent is not married with respondent No.7 who is in fact legally wedded with the petitioner and the marriage has not been dissolved till date. Thus, a representation dated 11.10.2021 (Annexure P-13) has been submitted before respondent No.6 but no action has been taken thereupon.

Notice of motion to respondents No.5 & 6 only.

Ms. Saigeeta Srivastava, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.5 & 6 and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity to seek a reply from the respondents.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.6 to decide the pending representation dated 11.10.2021 (Annexure P-13) in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order within 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
