The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.249 dated 09.11.2020 under Sections 323, 498A and 506 IPC registered at Police Station City Safidon, District Jind, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the instant petition has been filed by father in law, mother in law and sister in law of the complainant. He further contends that the petitioners had been falsely implicated in the present case, however, during investigation challan has been presented against Rohit Pandey and they were kept in column No. 2 after having been declared innocent by DSP, the Enquiry Officer.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant does not opposes the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the fact that during investigation the petitioners have been found to be innocent, the instant petitioner is allowed. The interim order dated 11.12.2020 is made absolute.
