Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is the second petition for grant of bail to the petitioner in a criminal case arising from FIR No.311, dated 04.09.2018, registered under Section 148/149/324/302/34 IPC, at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

The first application was disposed of on 10.09.2019, with the following order:-

Prayer is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.311 dated 04.09.2018 registered under Sections 148/149/324/302/34 IPC at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, this Court is of the considered view that present petition can be disposed of by requesting the trial court to expeditiously conclude the trial preferably within a period of one year.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of, accordingly."

On a specific direction, reply by way of affidavit of Ajaib

Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad, has been filed, specifying the role alleged against the petitioner in the aforesaid crime.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this court is not inclined to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner.

However, since the district courts have now been directed to resume normal working, therefore, the trial Court is requested to make sincere endeavour for the conclusion of the trial expeditiously.

Disposed of accordingly.
