The petitioner is seeking grant of interim bail for two months in case FIR No.21 dated 08.02.2019 under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur, on account of marriage of his sister.

In compliance of order dated 08.11.2021, learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Chand Singh PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sunam, District Sangrur which is taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

Learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the prayer of the learned counsel by submitting that 40 vials of intoxicant syrup labelled as ONEREX of 100 ml each containing Psychotropic substance Codeine Phosphate were recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner, in pursuance to a secret information received by the Police. He has further submitted that the petitioner

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was earlier also released on interim bail by the trial Court in March 2019. However, thereafter the petitioner absconded as result of which he was declared a proclaimed offender on 22.11.2019.

In the wake of the facts and circumstances as enumerated hereinabove, particularly , the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to accept his prayer for grant of the concession of interim bail for two months.
