The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.400 dated 30.06.2020, under Sections 302, 323, 506, 147 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Barwala, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no allegation that the petitioner has caused any injury to the deceased. The petitioner has been attributed injuries to the complainant with a stick. He further contends that several family members of the petitioner including her husband are in custody. She is a lady with two minor children. She is not involved in any other criminal case. She is in custody since her arrest on 23.08.2020.

Learned State counsel contends that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is a lady with a minor child, she is not attributed any injury on the deceased, she is in custody for over 6 months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
