The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-2) and writ of *mandamus* directing respondents to release the disability pension, ex-gratia lump sum compensation and all consequential benefits alongwith arrears @ 18% per annum and to release constant attendant allowance, for which, representation dated 29.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) has also been submitted before the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner,

the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the representation dated 29.06.2021 (Annexures P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
