HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J.

Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 144
dated 10.10.2020 registered under Sections 386, 392, 506 and 120-B IPC at
Police Station Barnala.

At this stage, learned State counsel, on instructions from SI
Baldev Singh, submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.12.2020, the
petitioner had handed over her mobile phone to the prosecution agency and
the inquiry was conducted by SP(D), Barnala and during enquiry the
petitioner was found innocent and accordingly cancellation report in the
present FIR qua the petitioner has been prepared and filed before the court
below.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case
and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court
finds merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The petitioner is

directed to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and if she is sought to be arrested, she shall be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

It is made clear that if pursuant to and in compliance with this order, the petitioner does not cooperate with the investigating agency, the investigating agency would be liberty to move an appropriate application for cancellation of bail.
