The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.92 dated 23.06.2018 registered under Sections 408, 420 IPC (Section 409 IPC added later on) at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners were found innocent during investigation. Challan was presented only against Harbant Singh Secretary of the Society. Thereafter the petitioners were summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. vide order dated 05.12.2019.

Notice of motion was issued on 10.12.2020 and in the

meanwhile the petitioners were directed to appear before the trial Court within two weeks and in the event of their appearance, the trial Court was directed to admit them on interim bail subject to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has sent a copy of order dated 14.12.2020 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar in the group in the context of appearance of the petitioners before the trial Court and grant of interim bail by the trial Court on their appearance.

In view of the aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 10.12.2020 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on appearing before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing. Failure on behalf of the petitioners before the trial Court would entail in cancellation of anticipatory bail in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of.
