The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.385 dated 12.09.2020, under Sections 307/506/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Ganaur, district Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioner and co-accused Golu Tyagi is alleged to have fired a shot but it did not hit anyone. He further contends that the petitioner is 21 year of age and is not involved in any other criminal case. He is in custody for over 4 months since his arrest on 14.09.2020.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Satbir, contends that challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above, especially when no injury is attributed to the petitioner, he is in custody for over 4 ½ months, the petitioner is 21 year of age, he is not involved in any other case, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
