Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.208 dated 03.10.2019, under Sections 323, 307, 324 IPC, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is alleged to have caused sword blows on the injured, who has fully recovered from the injury. The petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 10 months and does not have criminal antecedents.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate which indicates that the petitioner is in custody for 01 year, 09 months and 07 days. He upon instructions from ASI Manjit Singh states that charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 09 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
