SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed challenging the orders, whereby, the application filed by respondent Nos.3 to 6 for clubbing of outlet Nos.22115/L and 22885/L has been allowed.

A perusal of the order dated 29.07.2021 passed by respondent No.1 shows that clubbing of the two outlets would not affect any party adversely and at the same time, it would enable the private respondents to irrigate their land in a better manner. Increase in size of the outlet would increase the flow and if, there is an apprehension that the same might lead to breach of the khal, the same can be strengthened by the villagers.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that clubbing of the two outlets would adversely affect the interest of the petitioners as earlier, the khal had been breached.

In view of the findings of respondent No.1, the argument is mis-conceived.

No other argument has been raised and thus, the writ petition is dismissed.
