HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 to 10 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. It is further submitted that this is first marriage of petitioner No. 1 and second marriage of petitioner No. 2. They apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 10.

The certificate/Nikah Nama, evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexures P-4. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 20.10.2021 (Annexure P-6) to respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Nuh.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ashok Singh Chaudhary, Addl. A. G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Nuh, to decide the representation dated 20.10.2021 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioners and grant protection to the petitioners, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
