By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.31, dated 16.03.2019, having been registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420/406/120-B of the IPC.

The petitioner having been admitted to interim bail vide an order passed on 14.12.2020, today learned counsel for the complainant, on instructions, submits that in fact the entire money as was due to the complainant by the petitioner, has been paid by him, with a statement to that effect having been recorded before the learned Area Magistrate.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual

merits of the case, the present petition is allowed, with the order dated 14.12.2020, granting interim bail in favour of the petitioner, made absolute.
