1. Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

2. This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No.133, dated 25.03.2021, under Sections 193, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, and 120B IPC , registered at Police Station City Sohana, Gurugram.

2. The brief facts are that on an inquiry marked by Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram in a revision petition it was found that two slips issued by Navdeep Auto Corporation Pvt. Ltd were found fake and the present FIR was registered.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that case set up for grant of bail is that investigation is complete; challan stands presented and no recovery is to be made from the petitioner.

4. Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail. She submits that petitioner has criminal antecedents. He is involved in nine more FIRs. She fairly submits that challan was presented on

5. The investigation in the present case is complete; challan presented and no recovery is to be made from the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 12th August, 2021. The case is based upon documentary evidence, conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, considering the antecedents petitioner is granted bail, subject to furnishing heavy surety amount to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
6. The petition is allowed.
7. It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
