An order of partition was passed on 16.11.1993. The said order has been challenged by way of a revision petition after a delay of 9800 days. Thus, the learned Financial Commissioner has dismissed the revision petition on the ground of delay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a poor person and an illiterate. He was thus, not aware of his rights.

The aforementioned explanation is extremely lame and unacceptable. Just because a person is illiterate, it does not mean that he is not aware of his rights. In fact a large number of villagers are illiterate but they still pursue litigation with full force and vigor.

In view of the above, the learned Financial Commissioner was justified in dismissing the revision petition on the ground of delay.

The order is accordingly upheld and the writ petition is dismissed.
