CRM-M-41522 of 2020

This petition is filed challenging orders dated 19.10.2020 and
25.11.2020 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar, Mohali.
Non-bailable warrants (open) were issued against the petitioner.
Application filed by the petitioner under Section 70(2) Cr.P.C. for

cancellation of non-bailable warrants (open) issued in FIR No. 77 dated 6.5.2020 under Sections 302, 364, 201, 344, 330, 219 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was in Canada, on 27.12.2020 he has come back and put in appearance before the investigating agency. He further submits that the petitioner has been granted anticipatory bail. The grievance is that Look Out Circular (LOC) has been issued by the investigating agency.

Learned counsel for the State is not in a position to dispute the facts argued by learned counsel for the petitioner. He, however, submits that since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is rendered infructuous.

In view of the subsequent developments, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the court concerned for appropriate directions for re-calling of LOC as well as orders of issuance of non-bailable warrants (open). In case such an application is moved, the same shall be decided as expeditiously as possible.
