The status report by way of affidavit dated 13.07.2021 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira, District Ferozepur, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents, taking the plea that they performed the marriage with each other on 07.12.2020.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and he does not want to press the present petitioner.

Learned State counsel also submits that the statement of the petitioners and respondent No. 4-Paramjit Kaur (mother of petitioner No. 1) have been recorded. The petitioners in their statements submitted that now they have no apprehension from any person and respondent No. 4-Paramjit Kaur (mother of petitioner No. 1) has stated they they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition having been rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
