The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for the issuance of direction to respondents 2 to 5 to accept the family pension file of the petitioner in respect of her late husband and to send the same to respondent No. 6 i.e. Accountant General (A&E), U.T. Chandigarh and further directions to respondents to fix and release the family pension, pay the gratuity, DCRG, arrears of pension and all other pensionary benefits, for which, legal notice dated 09.08.2021 has also been served upon the respondent-

authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 09.08.2021 as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
