This is petitioner's fourth attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.0006 dated 16.11.2018 registered under Section 482, 483 IPC and Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station State Special Operations Cell, SAS Nagar, District Intelligence Wing (CID).

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith a co-accused was found in conscious possession of 10 kg opium. It has also come in evidence that at the time when the petitioner was apprehended alongwith his car, the number plate of the car was displaying a fake registration number.

Sh. Nikhil Chopra, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, has contended that the prosecution has already recorded the deposition of 11 witnesses out of a total of 21 witnesses to be examined.

The trial of the case has made substantial progress. Hence, in the considered opinion of the Court, it would be more appropriate to

request the trial court to conclude the trial positively, within a period of six months from today.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
