[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a comprehensive representation to be submitted to the respondent and directions being issued to the respondent to consider and decide the same on receipt in a time bound manner.

[2] The same is not opposed to by learned State counsel.

[3] Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of the petitioner submitting a representation to the respondent within three days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, the respondent is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within one week thereafter.
