This is the second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.PC for releasing the petitioner on bail in case FIR No.112 dated 02.05.2019 under Sections 363/366 IPC (Section 376(3) IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act added later on) registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Phase I, UT, Chandigarh.

No ground is made out to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner in the case in hand as learned State counsel has apprised the Court that two material witnesses i.e. victim, aged 14 years as well as the complainant, who is father of the victim, have supported the case of the prosecution in its entirety and reiterated the allegations levelled against the petitioner of raping the victim.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed. However, it is made clear that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
