The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant benefit of leave encashment for 450 days in lieu of unutilized earned leave lying at their credit on the date of superannuation along with interest @ 12% p.a.; as well as to decide the legal notice dated 17.06.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to him.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with

direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 17.06.2021 (Annexure P4) as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioners without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
