Through this writ petition, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to acquire the property of the petitioner which has been utilized for construction of Metro line/railway station.

Mr. Samarth Sagar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, has entered appearance for the respondents and has stated that he has instructions to inform the Court that the representation of the petitioner shall be decided by the competent authority within a period of two months.

It may be noted here that the certain other owners, who were similarly aggrieved, had filed Civil Writ Petition No.12118 of 2019 and other connected cases with an identical grievance. The aforesaid writ petition was disposed of after the Chief Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran has filed affidavit that the property has been taken away without acquisition and as a result the decision has been taken to compensate the owners in an adequate manner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of in terms of the statement made by Sh. Samarth Sagar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana. It is expected that the competent authority shall pass a speaking order after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within the aforesaid time.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
