1. This order shall decide CWP-21449-2020 and CWP-11109-2021.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the appeal filed by the petitioner against impugned order Annexure P/23 dated 09.11.2020, has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the appeal in a time bound manner while permitting the petitioner to continue in the government residential accommodation till the decision of the appeal by respondent No.3.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from ASI, Lavi No.321/DIR, SP Office, Sonapat, states that the appeal would be decided within such time as is granted by this Court.

4. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petitions are disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the appeal, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, within one month from today. In the meantime, order / notice Annexure P/19 dated 26.09.2019 (in CWP-21449-2020), shall be kept in abeyance till the decision of the appeal and further action in the matter would be taken only subject to the outcome of the appeal.
