Vide this petition, the petitioners' seeks a direction to respondents no. 2 to 4 to ensure that if she is required as a witness or for any other purpose in any investigation ongoing, due procedure of law as provided in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, be followed, specifically, Section 160 thereof.

The petition is consequently disposed of with a direction to respondents no. 2 to 4, i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Mansa, as also the SHO of Police Station Boha, District Mansa, to ensure that if the petitioner is to be joined in any investigation/even summoned as a witness, due procedure of law shall be followed, as laid down in the Cr.P.C., failing which naturally, the said respondents will be deemed to be in contempt of this order passed, other than of course being in violation of the provisions in the Cr.P.C. for which a separate remedy would also lie with the petitioner in any case.

It is made clear that this court has made no comment whatsoever on the merits of any allegations made in the petition but is disposing of the same only in view of the provisions of law as the respondents are bound to follow.
