This order shall dispose of CR-5222-2019 and CR-5274-2019.

The petitioner in both the revision petitions is common. He is judgment debtor in two execution petitions filed before the executing Court. There is a decree for recovery of Rs.4,00,000/- each in two different suits. The petitioner is stated to have paid the principal amount as noticed in the order dated 12.10.2021. The petitioner is required to pay the amount along with the interest at the rate of 6% per annum as per the judgment and decree passed by the First Appellate Court.

Since, the petitioner has already paid the principal amount therefore, the revision petitions are disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an application for payment of the amount of interest in installments.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
