Limited prayer for which the petitioner has come up before this Court is that condition of furnishing the bank guarantee to the tune of Rs.4,00,000/- or on deposit of cash of Rs.4,00,000/- to release the vehicle in question on *superdari*, be waived off.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not in a position to deposit the said amount and no purpose would be served in case the vehicle in question is not released.

Given the facts and circumstances of the case and financial distress caused due to Covid-19 Pandemic, the present petition is allowed and furnishing bank guarantee or cash deposit is hereby over-ruled. There is no necessity to furnish bank guarantee. Only a *superdari* with one surety of the like amount would be sufficient.
