Petitioners have filed this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 and 5, as they have solemnized marriage on 30.11.2020 against their wishes.

On 11.12.2020, State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat.

Today learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Raminder Singh Kahlon, PPS, Deputy superintendent of Police, Sri Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, Punjab on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, wherein it is mentioned that private respondent Nos.4 and 5 are not objecting to the alleged matrimonial alliance of the petitioners. Their joint statement is also appended with the status report, as Annexure R-1/T. He has also produced the joint statement of petitioners (Annexure R-2/T), wherein they stated that they are happily residing and have no threat from

private respondents.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petition is rendered infructuous.
