The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.91 dated 12.8.2021 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station, Women, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 2.11.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 2.11.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. Counsel further submits that the mediation proceedings between the parties, however, remained unsuccessful. The report sent by the Mediator affirms the same.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 2.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
