By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.269, dated 25.09.2016, having been registered at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 302/395 of the IPC.

Learned Addl. PP, UT, Chandigarh, submits that in fact the entire evidence in the case has been led, with only arguments to be addressed by the defence counsel.

That being so, I see no reason to entertain this petition at this stage, which is consequently dismissed.

Naturally, subject to counsel for the defence addressing arguments, the trial court would conclude the trial at the earliest.
