Through this criminal writ petition, the petitioners are praying for a writ of mandamus by way of directions to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty from private respondent Nos.4 to 11 as they have solemnized marriage on 08.12.2020 against their wishes.

On 16.12.2020, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are receiving threats from respondent Nos.4 to 11 as they have entered into marriage on 08.12.2020 against their wishes.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Counsel for the

petitioners undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General Punjab through e-mail, during the course of the day.

Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts and the existence of alleged threat.

On his request, adjourned to 11.02.2021.”

Today, no one has appeared in this case on behalf of the petitioners, however, status report by way of affidavit of Lakhvir Singh Tiwanan PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Barnala alongwith respective statements of the petitioners (Annexure R-1/T and R-2/T) and respondent No.4 (Annexure R-3/T) has been filed by the State, wherein the petitioners have stated that they do not apprehend any danger from anyone. Respondent No.4 (father of petitioner No.1) has also stated that he has no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners.

In view of the above, petition is rendered infructuous.
