Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.16 dated 30.10.2020, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961, at Police Station Women Cell, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Vide interim order dated 11.12.2020, the petitioners were granted interim stay and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in pursuance to the same.

On the other hand, learned counsel for respondent No.2 opposes the prayer made by counsel for the petitioners and submits that the husband is in Canada whereas, the parents-in-law do not deserve the anticipatory bail.

In view of the above position when both the petitioners have joined investigation, the interim order dated 11.12.2020, is made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
