The petitioner has filed present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to take into consideration representation dated 16.10.2020 made by the petitioner and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from danger at the hands of respondents No.3 to 8.

Short affidavit of Baldev Singh, P.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, (Headquarters), Amritsar (Rural), Supervising Officer of Police Station Kamboj has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 in the Registry which is taken on record.

In compliance with order dated 15.12.2020, passed by this Court, a report dated 28.01.2021 has been received from learned CJM-cum-Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Amritsar which is taken on record.

As per report submitted by CJM-cum-Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Amritsar no compromised could be arrived between the petitioner and respondent No.3 but as per the reply filed by respondents No.1 and 2, the petitioner and respondent No.3 have compromised; respondent No.3 also realised her mistake; and the petitioner and respondent No.3 are living together.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner does not want to proceed with the present petition any further and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.
