The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondents No.3 to 6, who are against the marriage of the petitioners.

On 11.12.2020, learned State counsel sought time to verify the existence of alleged threat.

Status report by way of affidavit of Waryam Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (Central), Ludhiana has been filed by learned State counsel wherein vide Annexure R-1/T, the petitioners have stated that they do not apprehend any danger from respondent No.3 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute this fact and submits that in view of the statement made by the petitioners, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
