The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for the grant of interim bail for attending the marriage ceremony of his sister, Rajwinder Kaur.

On 10.11.2021 the following order was passed:-

“The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for the grant of interim bail for attending the marriage ceremony of his sister, Rajwinder Kaur.

Before the prayer of the petitioner is considered, let the State file a status report with regard to the averments made in this petition. It should be mentioned in the status report, whether the presence of the petitioner is necessary so as to perform the marriage ceremony.

Adjourned to 16.11.2021.”

In furtherance to the order passed, a status report has been filed by learned State counsel, which is taken on record.

The report submitted by the Police shows that there is no marriage being solemnized as mentioned in the present petition, rather, the said assertion

has only been made to mislead this Court so as to secure interim bail. The conclusion has been supported by the Police alongwith the statement of the concerned Sarpanch and Nambardars of the village as well as the father of the petitioner.

This kind of attempt of securing bail is deplorable.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw this petition keeping in view the reply filed by learned State counsel.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
