Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.135 dated 19.09.2020, registered under Section 420 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Majhita Road, Amritsar Commissionerate.

On 03.11.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:

“The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.135 dated 19.09.2020, registered under Section 420 IPC, at Police Station Majhita Road, Amritsar Commissionerate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner had taken money from the complainant and others for setting up apartments in Luxury Tent City at Kartarpur Sahib corridor. He, however, contends that the FIR is an outcome of a monetary dispute and the petitioner is willing to settle the same through mediation.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the court, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Mr. Dilpreet Singh Gandhi, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and states that the complainant is also willing to settle the matter through mediation.

The parties shall appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this court on 12.11.2021.

List on 06.12.2021.

The arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.”

Learned counsel for the parties have stated that the attempt of the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court was fruitful and the parties have arrived at a settlement.

In view of above, the petition is allowed and in the event of arrest, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
