On being declared proclaimed offender in the above captioned FIR, the petitioner has come up before this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing.

2. Learned Additional Sessions Judge vide order dated 25.09.2012 had declared the accused as proclaimed offender on his non-appearance.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not aware of the dates otherwise he would appear before the learned Trial Court. He further assures that the petitioner shall appear on 22.11.2021 positively.

4. Given the current Covid-19 Pandemic coupled with the facts and circumstances peculiar to this case, this petition is allowed subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the concerned Trial Court on 22.11.2021 at

10:00 a.m. and in case for any circumstances beyond his control, he could not appear, he shall appear on 29.11.2021 and finally on 06.12.2021 at 10:00 a.m subject to condition that he shall furnish requisite personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned Court.

5. Since once this petition is allowed, the petitioner shall not be arrested till 06.12.2021
