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This case has been taken up in National Lok Adalat through

The matter has been amicably settled between the parties.

Respondent Nos.3 and 6 shall pay a sum of Rs. 9,00,000/- over
and above the amount of compensation already awarded by the Tribunal.
The respondent No.3-National Insurance Co. Ltd. shall pay an amount of
Rs.5,00,000/- and respondent No.6-Shriram General Insurance Co. Ltd.
shall pay an amount of Rs.4,00,000/- out of the enhanced amount of
compensation. The enhanced amount shall be apportioned amongst the
appellants as per the share determined by the learned MACT.

The Insurance Companies i.e. National Insurance Co. Ltd. and
Shriram General Insurance Co. Ltd. are directed to deposit the crossed-
cheques in the name of the appellants with the office of the Lok Adalat of
the High Court on or before 12.10.2021, in compliance of this order, failing
which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment

from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company.

The appeal is disposed of.

The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
