A bare perusal of the paper book shows that the matter lies within the jurisdiction of Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT). Although counsel for the petitioner has referred to the order dated 6.5.2021, passed by the Rajasthan High Court in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 5451 of 2021** titled as **Ajay Chandra v. Union of India**, however, even that order has been passed by mentioning that the CAT was not functioning in that state. But, that situation does not exist in this part of the country. Hence, the present petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach the CAT for the same cause of action.
