AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a prayer for consideration of his claim for grant of parole on the ground that the health of his wife is bad. Reference has also been made to the medical certificate and the prescription, copies of which have been appended along with the writ petition, to the effect that his wife is pregnant with 29 weeks and needs medical assistance. Petitioner had, accordingly, submitted a representation to the Jail Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, dated 10.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) for grant of parole on medical ground of his wife, which has, till date, not been responded to.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the representation submitted by the petitioner at an early date and grant the benefit to the petitioner, as claimed.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 10.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) and take a decision thereon within a period of one week from today. Decision, so taken, be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

Mr. Amitoj Singh Dhaliwal, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, is directed to convey the order to the competent authority during the course of the day.
