Petitioner is seeking directions to restrain the respondent-Indian Oil Corporation from giving effect to the letter dated 17.10.2018 (Annexure P-11) and further restrain the respondent-Corporation from cancelling the Letter of Intent dated 27.02.2015 (Annexure P-3) and from taking any other coercive action against the petitioner, in view of the fact that the 'No Objection Certificate' as sought by the respondent-Corporation has already been issued on 11.09.1967 (Annexure P-1) by respondent No.1 and the same is valid for all intents and purposes.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that since the petitioner has already been granted the requisite 'No Objection Certificate' by the concerned District Magistrate, therefor, he intends to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Since the main petition has been withdrawn by the petitioner, therefore, CM Nos.2906-CWP & 2936-CWP of 2021 for impleading the applicant(s) as respondent No.5 have been rendered infructuous.
