The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This civil writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned order dated 27.8.2018 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Financial Commissioner.

The dispute is with regard to appointment of the Headman (Lambardar) of the village. Learned Financial commissioner (Appeals), Punjab, has remitted the matter back to the Deputy Commissioner, District Amritsar to re-examine merits of each candidate. Learned counsel representing the petitioner admits that pursuant to the aforesaid order of remand, learned Deputy Commissioner has passed an order appointing respondent No.4 as Headman of the village. However, he would inform the Court that an appeal against the aforesaid orders of

Deputy Commissioner has been filed.

Keeping in view the subsequent developments, no further order is required to be passed.

Hence, the present writ petition is dismissed.
