Being aggrieved, the petitioner has come up before this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the impugned order dated 04.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) vide which the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person in complaint case No.69/2015, dated 11.09.2015 filed under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 3(1) (i) (ii) (iii) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a woman and at the time of passing order, she was out of country. Now, she intends to visit India and the facts of proclamation order come to her notice.

Given the current Covid-19 Pandemic coupled with the facts and circumstances peculiar to this case, this petition is allowed subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the concerned Trial Court on 15.11.2021 at 10:00 a.m. and in case for any circumstances beyond her

control, she could not appear, she shall appear on 22.11.2021 at 10:00 a.m subject to condition that she shall furnish requisite personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned Court. Failure to comply with this order shall result in automatic withdrawal under Section 362 Cr.P.C. without any reference to this Court.

The petition is allowed with the aforesaid terms.
