Prayer made in the application is for release of the applicant-petitioner on interim bail on the medical grounds.

Custody Certificate dated 10.07.2021 has been filed by the State, which is taken on record. State counsel, upon instructions from ASI - Nachhattar Singh submits that the petitioner was released on bail on 31.05.2021.

Counsel for the applicant-petitioner has informed the Court that while applicant-petitioner was on bail, he expired on 25.06.2021. He has placed his Death Certificate on the record.

Consequently the application has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.

On the oral request of the counsel for the applicant-petitioner, the hearing of the main case is preponed and is taken on Board today itself.
