Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.121 dated 04.10.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it was the complainant side which had attacked the petitioner and other accused in which Sukhdeep Singh has suffered grievous injuries. He further contends that petitioners' version was not recorded.

Learned State counsel contends that the petitioner is alleged to have caused a 'datar' blow on the right arm of the complainant which resulted in grievous injury and on the basis of medico legal examination at Civil Hospital, Patti, offence under Section 326 IPC was added.

Heard.

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The petitioner is alleged to have caused an injury with a ‘datar’ on the right arm of the complainant who is stated to be 80 years old. Therefore, I do not find it a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
