This is an application for fixing an actual date of hearing in the main case i.e. FAO No.5083 of 2013 for its disposal in terms of the compromise effected between the parties.

Notice of the application to the counsel opposite.

Mr. Vikas Gulia, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicants/appellants and submits that he has no objection if the main case is taken on Board for its disposal.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the main case is taken on Board today for its disposal.

Main Case

The instant appeal has been filed by the claimants/dependants/ legal representatives of deceased-Iqbal Singh seeking enhancement of the compensation awarded to them by the Commissioner under Employee's Compensation Act, Circle Kurukshetra. After adjudication upon the claim petition, the Commissioner under Employee's Compensation Act had

awarded an amount of ₹5,08,415/-, along with interest and benefits, as specified in that award.

Now it has been submitted by counsel for respondent No.2- Insurance Company, that the parties have amicably settled the dispute, under which respondent No.2 has agreed to pay the enhanced amount of ₹1 lac under all heads, over and above the amount which was awarded by the Commissioner under Employee's Compensation Act.

Counsel for the appellants has not disputed the above settlement between the parties and has expressed her no objection, to the disposal of the present appeal in terms of the compromise.

In view of the above, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the above said compromise, by awarding an amount of ₹1 lac under all heads, over and above the amount already awarded by the Commissioner under Employee's Compensation Act. It is further ordered that respondent No.2 shall deposit the above-said amount of ₹1 lac before the concerned Commissioner under Employees Compensation Act, Circle Kurukshetra, within a period of four weeks from today. The Commissioner shall disburse the same to the claimants, in accordance with law.
